## **Minutes**

Group rides. What is the impact of non-members turning up on a group ride.
The onus should not be on the group leader to insist the person joins before
riding. Where possible they should ask that the person joins. IA has confirmed
with our insurer, UK Cycling, that as long as there are less than 10 non
members, the group leader is covered. Below are UK Cycling clarifications to
our questions.

We organise group rides, and the UK Cycling insurance cover would appear to cover this, but does the group leader have to be UK Cycling member or just a club member?

No, the ride leader and any other group officials wish to be covered only need to be members of Chester Triathlon Club, not of Cycling UK.

Do we need to ask all our group ride leaders to join UK Cycling to have insurance cover?

Not at all, unless they'd like to join for the individual third party liability cover.

Do we need to name our group leaders somewhere within our UK Cycling club page?

You can register your leaders with us (by email) for peace of mind but it's not essential as long as you have a record of your Ride Leaders held somewhere.

Do we need to inform UK Cycling of our advertised group rides to enable insurance cover to be in place?

You only need to register rides and events with us if you're expecting more than 10 non-members of Chester Tri to take part, or if it's open to more than 200 participants.

- 7. Kit LW is discussing with suppliers before finalising the new cycle and triathlon designs.
- 8. Marshals for 2022 events MT will discuss with event organisers about 2022 plans.
- 9. Aquathlon dates yet TBC with JW. All other events confirmed in the club calendar
- 10. Dee Mile 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary plan MT considering options, but details not finalised.
